ROAD COMMITTEE REPORT: Met with Jesse Campbell today to go over the road updates for 2017 year. Road millage will be up for renewal next year also.

GLENNIE IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE: Mac addressed the board regarding the street lighting project – the committee is hoping to install 12 total lights (7 from M-65 to library 4 on one side of road and 3 on the other side & 5 from M65 down to the fire hall – 3 on fire hall side and 2 on other side). Bingo stated that they will be paying for a portion to have that done, as well as having boring and concrete footings installed. **MOTION:** Hopp/Bonner to accept the report and support the plan to have street lights installed. NEW BUSINESS: 1) Discussed the numerous problems with the hall that Supervisor Kenyon has been contacting Oscoda Schools about to no avail. IE: leaking roof, 1 out of 3 boilers work – Supervisor Kenyon had a roofing company come out and their suggestion was to have the whole roof replaced (which is not the township’s responsibility) – Supervisor Kenyon will be mailing inside the winter taxes an informational letter regarding the expenses incurred by the township hall w/projection for the upcoming years.
