**ZONING ADMIN:** 2 permit(s) issued, received 8 inquiries pertaining to zoning issues.

**ORD. ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:** Received 1 complaint(s) this month, issued one (1) violation for blight.

**ROAD COMMITTEE REPORT:** 1) The Curtis Twp Road Committee (CTRC) met with Jesse Campbell, ACR Manager and presented the townships road priorities for 2018. 2) Jesse presented additional ACRC priorities for Curtis Twp roads in 2018, 3) Jesse will develop costs/funding for the combined priorities and bring them back to the road committee for final approval. 4) The CTRC will meet with Jesse in January 2018 to finalize the budgeted road projects for Curtis Township’s 2018 maintenance season. 5) The CTRC will present the 2018 Finalized Road Projects, hopefully at the February or March 2018 meeting so that the Curtis Township Board of Trustees may approve.

**PLANNING COMMISSION:** The next meeting will be in January of 2018, when hopefully the revised Master Plan will be ready to be presented to the Curtis Township Board of Trustees.

**GLENNIE IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE:** The wiring is complete, and the lights are up, waiting on

Consumers Energy to set the meter. They are being advised it could take a month or longer. Discussed different ways that the meter set board could be cleaned up a bit so that it is not such an eyesore. IE: Flowers/shrubs/painting etc.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** In response to Clouse LLC request the letters have been mailed to Assessor, Tammy Fall, Zoning Administrator, John Karoly as well as Bryon Clouse (who had filed the requests)

**NEW BUSINESS:** 1) Cleaning of township hall, discussed.. 2) Received no bids for snowplowing so Clerk Perkins will run the ad again and try to contact a local person. 3) Supervisor Kenyon to contact someone with Asplundh and have them not park on grass at the fire hall but to park on the cement.
