

The 2019 Curtis Township Dust Control Policy

Adopted 04/11/19

There are two components to the Curtis Township 2019 Dust Control Policy

- I. Dust control that the **Township provides** (County contracts to have it applied)
- II. Dust Control that the **Township reimburses** the public for their expense.

Curtis Township provided Dust Control Policy:

- We will provide one (1) application (20 foot wide) of petroleum based dust control this year.
- We will dust control approximately five (5) miles of Curtis Township roads. This will include over 400 residences.
- Notification:
 1. We will notify in writing, each residence that receives a **new** spot drop this season. This letter will outline the Townships and the public's responsibilities.
 2. We will place a notice in the Curtis Community News and the Curtis Township Website indicating the roads involved.
- We must purchase a petroleum solution at a cost of approximately \$18,044.00
 1. (If paid within 10 days of application).
 2. (\$.70 / lineal foot @ 20' road width, a total of approximately 26,400 feet or 5 miles)
- The costs will be covered by the Curtis Township Road Millage (the costs are a part of the four year road plan budget).

Curtis Township reimbursement Policy:

- Curtis Township shall reimburse residence who, for the first time, contract with a licensed road dust control company for their services.
- Residence must submit a paid 2019 receipt / invoice from that company.
- The Township will reimburse at a rate of \$.40 a foot up to 300' and not more than \$120.00.
- In no case shall the Township pay an amount more than the "paid 2019 receipt".
- All paid receipts **MUST** be turned in to the Township Clerk by September 30, 2019.
- Any Property owner receiving their dust control from the Township will **not** receive a reimbursement for any additional dust control that is applied this season.

What will happen next?

- A. The Township will publish the dust control policy.
- B. The Township will notify ACRC of the spot drops and roads to be dust controlled.
- C. The Alcona County Road Commission (ACRC) will contract with the dust control provider.
- D. The ACRC will "prepare" the specific roads to be dust controlled and bill the Township.
- E. The Provider will deliver and apply the dust control.
