CORRESPONDENCE: N/A **PERSON’S WISHING TO ADDRESS THE BOARD:** 1) Sheriff Scott Stephenson updated the board and audience with several items and happenings within Alcona County including some scams that are happening (Publishers Clearing House and Visa Prepaid Cards), liquor inspections will be done by county and the department now has a snowmobile which he will be riding. 2) Geri Moody inquired as to why the minutes were not being published in the paper any longer, Clerk Perkins responded that the board is not publishing the whole minutes in the paper and when she published a synopsis she was advised that it was just a waste of money so she stopped. If anyone would like a copy of the minutes, they should contact her, and she would mail a copy to them. The minutes are always available online and a copy is hanging at the township office.
