ORD. ENFORCEMENT OFFICER: OEO Belanger reported that he has hand delivered 2 violations and made several inspections on blight complaints.

CEMETERY COMMITTEE REPORT: Scanning of old documents is going good, received an email regarding a Civil War Veteran in the Curtisville Cemetery who did not have a head stone, a couple of women have been working over 10 years to update all the cemeteries around with headstones for Civil War Veterans. We are happy to announce that this veteran now has a headstone.

ROAD COMMITTEE REPORT: All road projects are on hold until 2021 – unless it would be an emergency per Jesse Campbell. Larry Lane stated that it was with much regret that he was resigning from the CT Road Committee.

3) Alan Fisher would like to be reimbursed for his phone usage during his duration as CTZA. Discussed that months ago Alan stated that he did not want to get paid for his phone, he had a choice to get a township owned Tracfone and chose not to get one. **MOTION** to not pay Alan for his phone usage Perkins/Bonner Ayes – 5 Nays 0 – Motion Carried

NEW BUSINESS: The township had the bi-annual state mandated audit this week, the audit should be closed by the end of September.
