ZONING ADMIN/ORD. ENFORCEMENT OFFICER: Issued 3 permits and approved 1 land split, several inquiries about building projects, sent out 4 ordinance violation letters, getting a few responses, will start issuing citations to those who are not in compliance.

CEMETERY COMMITTEE REPORT: Volunteers are welcome to join us on May 26th at 10 a.m. starting at the Glennie Cemetery to put new flags on Veterans graves.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Need approval from Township Board on the new Blite Ordinance, Board is to review and discuss at June meeting.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: 1) Bonner/ Hopp make Motion to approve ACRC agreement #CU2201 in the amount of \$25,861.00 to Fog Seal from North Lake Road west to M 65 4 ayes; 1 Nay from Clerk Petty, motion carried. 2) Clouse/Bonner make motion to approve ACRC agreement #CU2202 in the amount of \$31,375.00 to sealcoat Brodie Rd from Clouse Rd north to Park Road and Park Road east, 5 ayes, motion carried. 3) Need to work with ACRC to come up with a solution for the dust control on Bissonette Rd, residents are under the impression that Bissonette is supposed to be chip sealed like Rickel/Clouse Road Vaughn Lake/Deerland. 4) Petty/Hopp make a motion to increase Supervisor, Clerk and Treasurer salaries by \$200.00 per month and the Fire Chiefs salary by \$150.00 per month, 5 ayes, Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS: Need to look into getting the curbs cleaned in town. The Township will begin getting 25% of PILT Monies back from the County beginning in January of 2023.
