Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Curtis Township, of 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) be renewed at 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) and levied for 4 years, 2022 through 2025 inclusive, for road improvement and construction within the Township, raising an estimated \$133,930.05 in the first year the Millage is levied.
